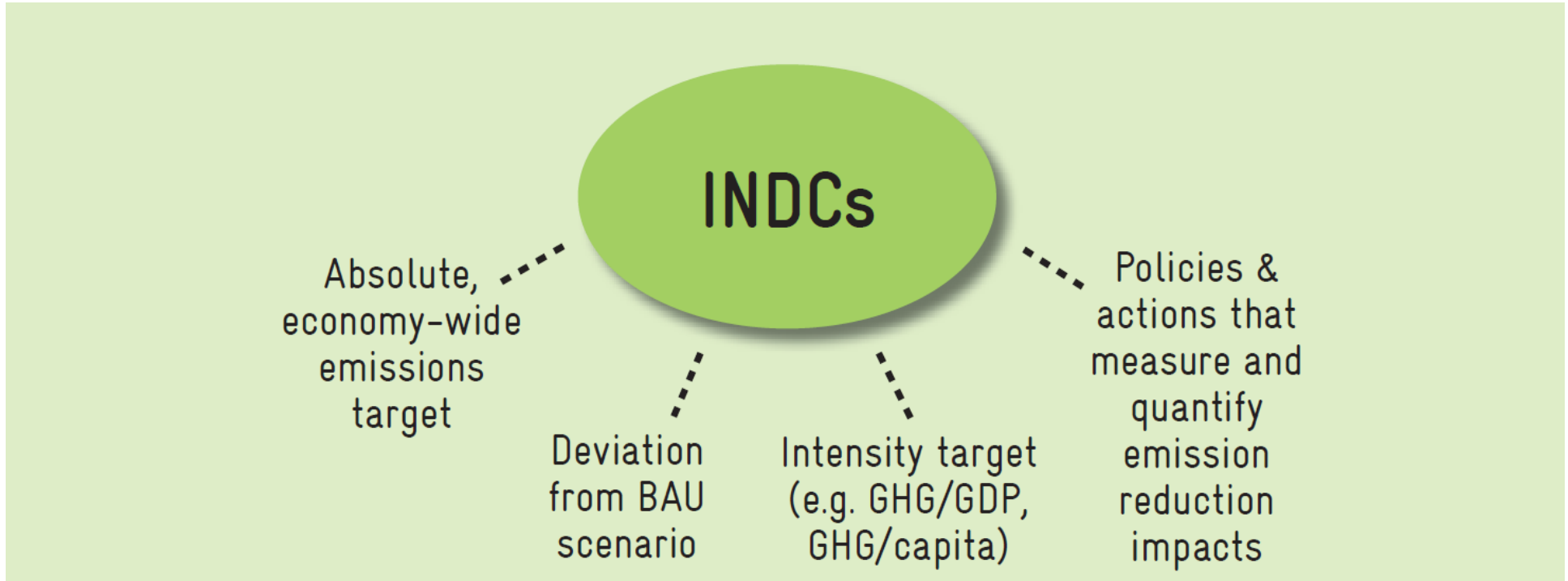

NAMAs - Pledges and Mitigation

Implementation tool

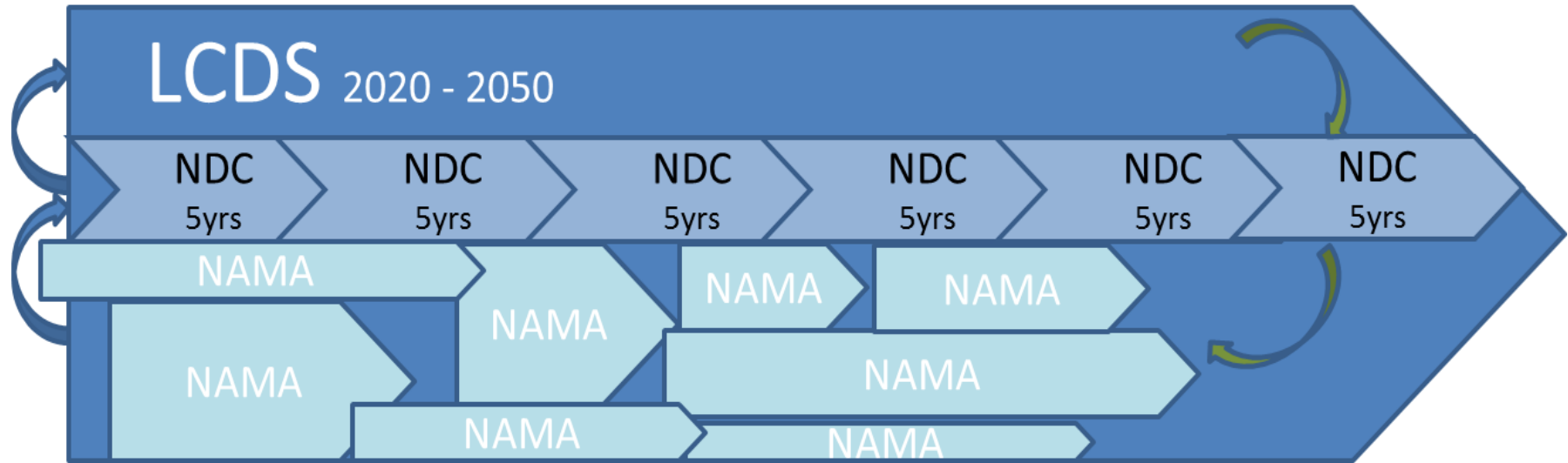
- NAMAs - term used for two types of mitigation action:
 - Country voluntary goals/pledges pursuant to Cancun Outcome on Mitigation architecture for developing countries
 - These were of different natures -
 - Economy wide goals (absolute emissions reductions, reductions below BAU, emission intensity targets, etc)
 - Policy (e.g., RE targets) or sector targets (e.g., Afforestation targets)
 - Collection of specific mitigation actions (e.g., Districting heating renovations, public transport infrastructure in Urban areas, etc.)
 - Specific mitigation actions as NAMAs for international support (e.g., Columbia TOD, Mexican energy efficient housing, etc.)
 - The first category - a goal/pledge as a parallel to the Developed country pledges on economy wide emission reduction targets below a base year or what could be now termed as NDCs.

INDCs



- INDCs/NDCs - a wide range of targets/goals depending on respective capabilities of countries for period 2020-2025/2030.

LERDS/LCDS, INDCs/NDCs, and NAMAs



- **Low Emissions and Resilient Development Strategy (LERDS) or Low Carbon Development Strategy (LCDS)** is the long term strategy/goal, which help coordinate a synergetic approach to sustainable development and decoupling emissions from development
- **INDCs/NDCs** - ideally linked to LERDs/LCDCs, translate strategy to medium term targets for mitigation in context of sustainable development
- **NAMAs** - implementation instruments to translate medium term goals into specific policies and actions to achieve the goal.

NAMAs & INDCs - the interlinkages

- NAMAs helped countries identify mitigation opportunities in sectors, and thus also contributed to development of INDCs
- INDC are goals and countries are developing implementation plans, NAMA as tool helps define the implementation of INDC goals.
- Capacities, human and institutional, developed in countries for NAMAs identification, development and implementation is above context are relevant to INDCs.
- MRV capacities and systems will enable tracking of progress in INDCs implementation, as per Transparency Framework.

UNEP-GEF INDC Support project

- UNEP/UDP is providing NDC implementation support through two projects: UNEP-GEF INDC Support project and Global Support Programme (GSP) for INDC preparation; and, Facilitating Implementation Readiness for Mitigation funded by the Danish Government.
- The project supported 36 countries (of which UDP was technical support provider in 31), of which 35 countries submitted their INDCs prior to Paris COP

- Out of 31 countries, 10 countries indicated that they used NAMA for INDC preparation and implementation.
